

# Wire Screen Rocking Sifter

Sifting screens used in forensic archeology applications to recover small evidence, remains, and artifacts from soil or debris at suspected crime scenes. Helps investigators uncover materials that may be missed during standard scene processing.

### Construction

- White pine frame construction
- Water-repellent lacquer coating
- Rust-proof fasteners
- Smoothed edges for safer handling
- Replaceable screen trays for different mesh sizes

### Performance

- Used to recover small evidence from soil/debris
- Assists in locating buried or overlooked remains and artifacts
- Helps estimate burial context and time-related evidence
- Can be used in varied terrain and crime scene conditions
- Supports single-person or team field recovery
- Easy cleaning and reuse in multiple scenes
